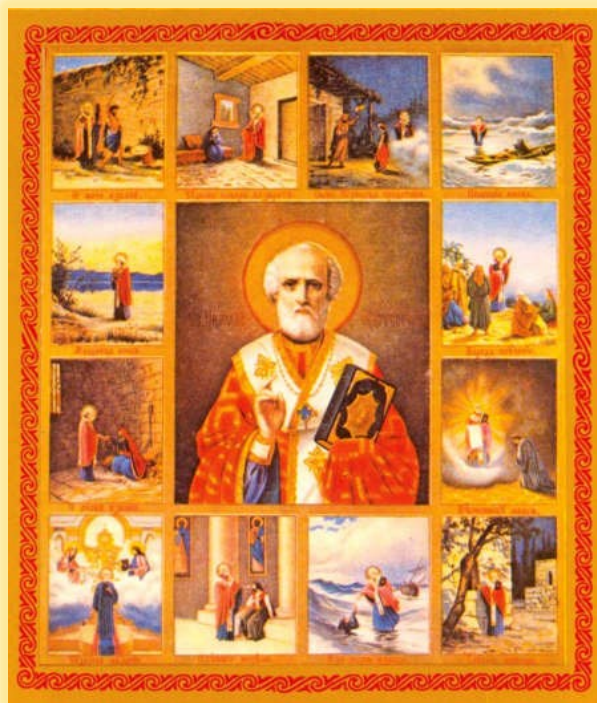

St. Nicholas of Myra

On Dec. 6, the faithful commemorate a bishop in the early church who was known for generosity and love of children. Born in Lycia in Asia Minor around the late third or fourth century, St. Nicholas of Myra is more than just the inspiration for the modern day Santa.

As a young man he is said to have made a pilgrimage to Palestine and Egypt in order to study in the school of the Desert Fathers. On returning some years later he was almost immediately ordained Bishop of Myra, which is now Demre, on the coast of modern day Turkey.

The bishop was imprisoned during the Diocletian persecution and only released when Constantine the Great came to power and made Christianity the official religion of the Roman Empire.

One of the most famous stories of the generosity of St. Nicholas says that he threw bags of gold through an open window in the house of a poor man to serve as dowry for the man's daughters, who otherwise would have been sold into slavery.

The gold is said to have landed in the family's shoes, which were drying near the fire. This is why children leave their shoes out by the door, or hang their stockings by the fireplace in the hopes of receiving a gift on the eve of his feast.

St. Nicholas is associated with Christmas because of the tradition that he had the custom of giving secret gifts to children. It is also conjectured that the saint, who was known to wear red robes and have a long white beard, was culturally converted into the large man with a reindeer-drawn sled full of toys because in German, his name is "San Nikolaus" which almost sounds like "Santa Claus."

In the East, he is known as St. Nicholas of Myra for the town in which he was bishop. But in the West he is called St. Nicholas of Bari because, during the Muslim conquest of Turkey in 1087, his relics were taken to Bari by the Italians.

St Nicholas is the patron of children and of sailors. His intercession is sought by the shipwrecked, by those in difficult economic circumstances, and for those affected by fires.

He died on December 6, 346.

Св. Миколай Чудотворець

У перекладі з грецької ім'я Миколай означає "той, хто перемагає народ" – на інших мовах – Ніколас, Ніклас, Клаус, Мікулаш, Мікрос, Ніхол...

Святий Миколай народився близько 270 року в місті Патарі, в Лікії, південно – західній області Малої Азії. Після смерті єпископа міста Міри, головного міста Лікії, (зараз м. Демре в Туреччині) він був обраний єпископом цього міста. Батьки святого Миколая належали до одного з найвідоміших та найбагатших лікійських родів. Довгі роки в них не було дітей. Миколай був їхнім єдиним, вимоленим сином. Благочестиві батьки дбайливо виховували свого сина в християнському дусі, а дядько Миколая, який був єпископом патарським, дбав про його освіту.

З юних літ Миколай відзначався глибокою побожністю, піклувався про вбогих та нужденних і, згідно з рішенням своїх благочестивих батьків, вибрав духовний сан.

Близько 300 р. в Мірі вибухла велика епідемія. Миколай, незважаючи на небезпеку, допомагав хворим, утішав їх. Під час цієї епідемії померли його батьки. Миколай успадкував велике багатство, яке роздав бідним і нужденним. Не чекав, щоб у нього просили допомоги, а сам шукав бідних, щоб їм допомогти. Не дивно, що з його ім'ям пов'язана традиція, яка сягає XII століття – давати допомогу та стипендії в школах. Пізніше цей звичай перетворився в дарування, особливо дітям, у надвечір'я святого Миколая подарунків. Зараз, під час цього гарного і повного глибокого значення звичаю, святого Миколая часто зображують у вигляді Санта Клауса. Проте християни повинні знати і пояснювати своїм дітям, звідки походить цей звичай – дарувати їм подарунки в день святого Миколая, та ким був цей Святитель.

Святий Миколай був прикладом християнського життя, на практиці прагнув реалізувати подвійний аспект християнської любові – Бога та ближнього і робив це так, як написано в Євангелії: "Нехай не знає ліва рука, що дає права"(Мт 6, 3), "Непоказуйте своїєї праведності перед людьми, щоб вони вас бачили і хвалили за те; нехай знає про ваші добрі діла лише Отець Небесний"(пор. Мт 6, 1-4).
