Dear Bishops,

I am writing to you to inform you about a new initiative geared towards raising awareness to the persecution experienced by our brothers and sisters in faith. There are **200 million** in the world that are touched by **persecution** to various degrees. We want to make them known and to be in solidarity with them.

To that effect, Aid to the Church in Need is organizing **Red Wednesday**. The event is taking place on **November 21**, **2018**. We invite dioceses, who can then inform their parishes, to participate according to their capacities. We suggest that they organize a mass, a vigil, a rosary, etc., to pray for the **persecuted Christians**. We have prepared the material for you in order to facilitate the organization of your participation to Red Wednesday.

I am attaching a more detailed explanatory document. You can also go on the web at http://acn-canada.org/red-wednesday/ to find the information and documents pertaining to this event that we are holding across the country. Some dioceses, namely those of Montreal and Toronto, have already confirmed their participation. Join us and tell us what you do so that we can publicize it.

Whatever you do, a small or big event, it will go straight to the heart of our project partners who suffer from persecution. Our prayer is their strength.

Looking forward to hearing from you, let's stay united in prayer for our persecuted brothers and sisters.

Most western people today do not fully understand the nature and scope of persecution.

That is why Red Wednesday aims to raise awareness among Christians on what is happening in the world and wants to encourage them to act through prayer and, in another way, by supporting the projects of Aid to the Church in Need in Iraq, in Syria or in any other country where persecution is experienced.
