Лука 5: 1-11

Євангелія від Луки 5:1-11 оповідає нам про Проповідь Ісуса на березі моря. Втомлені після неуспішної праці рибалки слухали потішаючі слова Ісуса, при цьому вони не сподівались, що це буде продовженням їхнього робочого часу.

По закінченні своєї проповіді Ісус просить Симона (майбутнього апостола Петра) знову повернутися до праці. Не дуже хочаючи виконують прохання Духовного наставника. Стається диво. Неуспішні стають успішними і це стає явним діянням Бога у їхньому житті, вони відчувають свою недостойність, хочуть тримати відстань, але Ісус кличе їх стати "рибалками людей", тобто місіонерами, його співробітниками у Божому Царстві.

Діверитися Богові – це важливо. В цій історії можемо звернути увагу на те, що втомлені неуспішні рибалки скористали із можливості послухати проповідь Месії, більше того послужити Йому у святій справі – дали Йому свого човна. Це може стати прекрасним прикладом для кожного з нас, щоб не закритися у своїй печалі, коли і нас спіткає неуспіх, трудність, брак очікуваного результату. Досвід показує, що люди, які впадають у відчай, розчарування, нарікання з причини іншого неуспіху, ще більше ускладнюють ситуацію, бо втрачають залишки іскри надії продовжувати жити і йти вперед.



Тому закриватися у своїх невдачах, оплакувати свої біди – це не тільки марна трата часу, але небезпечно!

Рибалки не впіймали рибу, але наповнились словами Спасителя, вони не залишились порожніми. Ми не знаємо, що вони чули, але ми знаємо, що слова Спасителя були потішливими для них та стали основою зробити майже абсурдну справу – повернутися до праці.

Все вказувало, що втішлого результату не буде, але на слово Учителя новий “учень” закидає сіті. Успіх приходить не з людського досвіду і не від людських старань, а з Божої волі та послуху.

Послухати Бога – це важливо

Наші неуспіхи заглушують нас і перед Богом і перед ближніми, і перед своєю душею. Бути глухим в час труднощі – це абсурдно.

Молитву ми дуже часто розуміємо, як вміння вилити Богові свою душу, як просити Бога про щось наболіле, як можливість щось Богові сказати. А почути? Бо можемо мати уста відкриті, а вуха, серце закритими.

Сьогоднішня історія нам нагадує про те, що потрібно навчитися Бога слухати, особливо тоді, коли є багато причин стати “глухим”.

Reflection on Luke 5:1-11

“The Lord created every dimension of our life and every bit of the universe. He calls us and it to become holy. No matter our circumstances, He calls each of us to offer our lives, including our frustrations and failures, to Him for healing and fulfillment. Just as He used a failed night of fishing for the salvation of the world, He wants to use us for His glory in ways that we cannot predict or fully understand.

It is tempting to think how nice life would be if we always got our way on our own terms and time table. But if that were the case, we would never get over our self-centeredness and impatience. We would never sympathize with others who were not so successful. We would have little chance of becoming fishers of men if we easily caught everything that we pursued purely

by our own ability. We would probably become so addicted to our own success that we would never leave behind our nets and follow Christ.

Of course, no one’s life is really a simple story of going from one success to another. As we all know in various ways, life is often so difficult that it takes effort to resist the temptation to despair, to simply abandon all hope of experiencing God’s presence and blessing in our lives. It is so tempting to focus on our failures, limitations, and distractions. That is why we must embrace prayer, fasting, repentance, and other spiritual disciplines in order to gain the spiritual strength to persevere, to continue the journey of taking up our cross and following Him.

No matter how hard life is, God’s salvation is not reserved for some other time and place. “Now is the acceptable time. . . now is the day of salvation.” If we do not hear and respond to His calling today, right now in our present circumstances, then when will we? If we wait for everything to become perfect according to our own preferences, we will never obey Christ and play our unique roles in the salvation of the world. That was true for those first disciples and it is still true of us. Despite their disappointment, they had to let their nets down one more time, even though they probably did not really believe that the results would be any different from those of the previous night. But St. Peter had enough faith at least to obey Christ’s command and to try one more time. And that is when their lives changed forever.

The next time that we are tempted to think that there is no hope for us in participating more fully and faithfully in the life of Christ, let us at least have as much faith as those fishermen who let down their nets one more time. That is how they became fishers of men, great apostles and evangelists who offered their lives to the Lord and became instruments of the salvation of the world. By God’s grace, may the same be true of us as we refuse to be distracted from hearing and obeying His call each day of our lives.” Fr. P.M.
