Viktoriia Marko continues to develop our social justice program with Ukraine. She has done this by first establishing a relationship with the Ukrainian Parish of The Protection (Pokrova) of our Blessed Virgin Mary Church in Sambir. Her first projects are built around Youth, the disabled, their relationship with Jesus Christ and their access to His Church. In this regard Viktoriia has: produced a high-quality video about the better access that disabled parishioners have at St. George's as compared to the access available in Sambir

begun assembling teams at St. George's and Sambir to prepare a unique Youth Fashion Show that will exemplify the themes of Youth and Christianity

collaborated with Laurianne Gabruch who is working on a plan to have a student group from Sambir come to Saskatoon at Easter

This will all come together — youth from Ukraine (hopefully) and Saskatoon, fashion show, video — at a presentation this Easter. We hope you will all come and enjoy this production at a date and place to be announced.






