Open My Eyes Lord

How are your eyes? Do you wear glasses or contacts? Do you have a lazy eye? Tired eyes? Tear-filled eyes? Dry eyes?

Seeing is believing for many. If they can't see they have little reason to believe. If the tunnel is filled with darkness, seeing the light at the end seems impossible at times. Many people want to believe; they just can't see.

How do you see clearly into the future? I believe to be able to see ahead of you involves knowing where you stand today and where you came from yesterday. I tell others that if you want to know where you're going, turn around and look where you came from. That's the best clue.

Looking where you came from can do a couple things. First, if you are on the wrong path of life by looking at what you've done can be an eye-opening experience. Every one of us has had our eyes opened in one way or another by looking at our past experiences and making the necessary adjustments to get back on course. I know we have more times than we can count or willingly admit.

Others use their past as motivation for where they want to be in the future. There are plenty of rags to riches success stories about those who had nothing but worked faithfully to overcome adversity and make a better life for themselves.

Sadly, many still have eyes that can't see or won't see where they are at present. They can't see how their actions hurt others. They can't see poverty. They can't see a better way. Many won't see a better tomorrow because of crime or oppression.

How are your eyes? How do you see things yesterday, today and tomorrow?

All of us can pray that our eyes be opened but are we really ready to see what God has planned for us? Spend some time today and really ask God to open your eyes!


