



#### WE BEGIN TO TELL OUR STORIES

After spending the past two years getting to know each other as neighbours and friends, the parishioners of Our Lady of Guadalupe Roman Catholic (First Nations and Metis Nation) Church and the parishioners of St. George's Ukrainian Catholic Cathedral are continuing their important journey of getting to know each other as different Peoples with powerful stories to tell about their experiences surviving in this world.



The first **Evening of Storytelling** will be held on **Wednesday**, **June 19**, at Guadalupe's Parish Office at 426 Avenue J, South, from 7:00 - 8:30 pm. This event begins a series of storytelling evenings that will be held about three times a year, with the venue alternating between the two churches. The events will be interactive and educational, providing each community an opportunity to learn about each other's life experiences, to understand why we think and act as we do, and to grow together in Christian love with those whom we see but do not really know. As a recent Catholic meditation put it:

Discipleship is cross-cultural. When we meet Jesus around people who are just like us and then continue to follow Jesus with people who are just like us, we stifle our growth in Christ and open ourselves up to a world of division. However, when we're rubbing elbows in Christian fellowship with people who are different from us, we can learn from each other and grow more like Christ.

Please come to this and future Evenings of Storytelling and share your experiences and thoughts (Ukrainian Catholic) and listen to others share theirs (First Nations and Metis Nations). The program will include opening prayers, plenary speakers followed by small groups to discuss the story told by the respective speakers, refreshments and fellowship, summary statements from the groups, and closing prayers. More details about the speakers and topics will be provided in next Sunday's Bulletin. St. George's and Guadalupe embarked on this journey of friendship three years ago agreeing that we felt led by the Holy Spirit. May the Holy Spirit lead you to join us in this deeper journey together.




