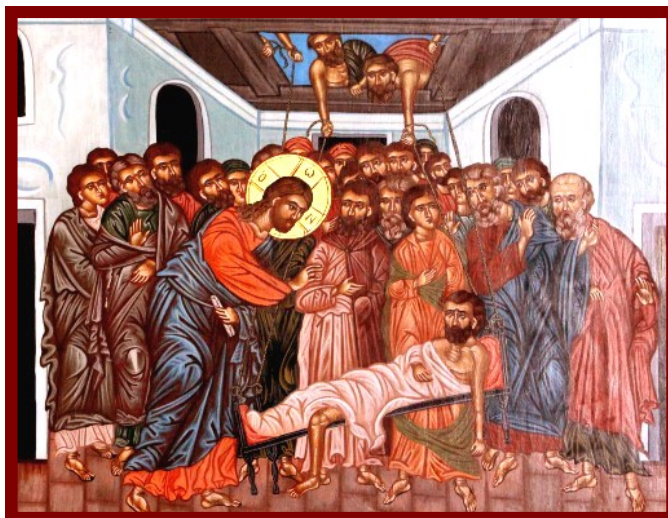

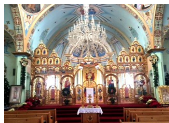

Great Fast Reflections - Human & Environmental Development Program – Dr. Lesya Sabada

Part 1: The Problem

How can the Church respond to ecological challenges while maintaining a focus on the Great Fast?

Purpose: Christianity seeks to strengthen the Kingdom of God by promoting good thoughts and deeds, especially during the Great Fast. For Eastern Church focuses on the restoration of the image of God. It is not set of imperatives. The goal is the imitation of Christ. It's a mode of being that is most practical and of the highest quality.

How does this translate into an approach to environmental issues? The richness of Eastern Christian theology of creation and its potential for giving a sense of spiritual direction at a time of environmental challenge, have become much more widely recognized in recent years. The environmental crisis is symptomatic of a spiritual crisis. We must recognize that the Church engages with contemporary society in a very different way from any secular organization. Its concern is not with transforming structures but with transforming humanity. Transforming human beings means working on the inner self, wrestling with greed, selfishness, laziness, willful blindness and so forth, that distort my relationship with my Creator and creation alike. Paradoxically, this act of turning inward to work within oneself is also the bedrock of any social and structural change.

What's the Problem: Connected to this Eastern Christian view is the recognition of a problem with self-centeredness and evil imperfection within us. Self-centeredness is a bondage and a slavery. Sin is a block-out, a separation, a turning away from God to center on oneself. Humanity's course in life becomes centered on oneself.

Glory be to Jesus Christ!

To the clergy of the Eparchy of Saskatoon

This year and following, I would like to emphasize the **Feast of the Annunciation, Monday March 25, 2019**, so that all the Ukrainian Catholic Churches in the Eparchy of Saskatoon would focus on the celebration of the Incarnation of Christ as a specific issue of “Human Life” being **life from conception onwards**. Feel free to mention other life issues of a broad range that are working against this, such as contraception or euthanasia. Focus on **CHOOSING LIFE** (and how **abortion, intentional killing**, is in direct opposition to this).

In addition to a homily on the subject of Choosing Life, please consider saying special prayers during the *Insistent Ektenia* regarding:

- intentions for those in power who permit this killing of the innocent in our country,
- that the hearts of those who perform abortions will be converted,
- women who are harmed spiritually, psychologically and physically by this self-centered choice or are somehow coerced into this “so called” choice.
- their entire families who also suffer the trauma of loss and the children who are victims of abortion

In time, I strongly recommended that your parish have a special event such as a prolife speaker or the gathering of baby items in support of one of our provinces Pregnancy Options Center. This could also take place on the Sunday before or post feast. If you do not have time to organize a big event this year choose something smaller but please do something.

You can also put it on your calendar, and your Pastoral Council’s calendar, to plan for next year as I would like this to become an annual event. If you need information on this issue please contact Deborah Larmour of the Family and Life Office and she will be pleased to support your efforts. I would also like you to contact her office by email to let her know of your plans so we can promote the events throughout the Eparchy and others can be inspired by your activities. 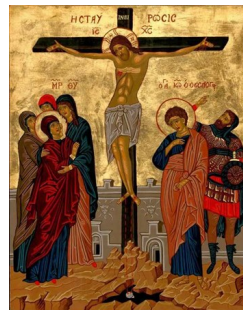

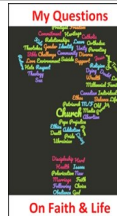
