

Dear Mr.... and Mrs....,

"It's beginning to look a lot like Christmas!"

That old refrain – and Christmas itself -- is not quite the same during this unusual year. In many ways, this PYLYPIWKA (Advent) and Christmas season does not look as it usually does. We are not able to gather or to celebrate as we usually do, with reduced numbers undoubtedly continuing well into the New Year. Preparations, expectations, and long-standing traditions are requiring modification.

Setting aside how we think Christmas should *look*, let us pause to remember and connect to how Christmas *appeared*. "And there were shepherds out in the field, keeping watch by night. And an angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them." Luke 2:8-9

While Christmas celebrations may indeed look different this year, the light of Jesus Christ coming into our world continues to be true and real, regardless of the circumstances. A light is being shone, and an opportunity is being given.

In the midst of the pandemic and the associated safety protocols, our mission to proclaim Christ and to reach out in service continues. At the same time, this has brought challenges and mounting concern about how best to continue our mission and meet the needs of our parish. Resources are required more than ever during these extraordinary times.

Since the outbreak of the pandemic, we have been and will continue to strive to serve our faith community in new and emerging ways. Our priorities have been to:

- ... implement regulations regarding public worship in order to accommodate in-person worship in the safest possible manner
- ... offer extra Liturgy times to enable more people to attend, given restrictions on numbers
- ... offer a platform for online Liturgies for those who have not yet returned to in-person celebration of the Eucharist ... find ways to accommodate funerals, weddings, sacramental preparation and other important milestones in the lives of parishioners
- ... keep important information flowing and available to all parishioners
- ...bring prayers, presence and sacraments to those whose families are unable to visit loved ones while they are in hospital, In order for all such efforts to continue and hopefully to expand resources are needed.

The PYLYPIWKA (Advent) and Christmas Liturgies are traditionally a critical source of funds for the parish. In addition, because of the disruption to regular Liturgy attendance, gatherings and events over the past nine months, collection revenue has fallen well below the operational level needed to sustain the life our parish. In normal times, this weekly generosity directly supports a wide range of ministries, initiatives and outreach that many rely upon. While our collections have dropped, our ministry and outreach are needed more than ever during this pandemic.

Truly, everyone's lives have been disrupted through the COVID-19 pandemic. It has, and for the foreseeable future will impact how we worship and how we engage in programs offered by our parish. Humbly, yet candidly, I share with you that your financial assistance is needed to ensure the parish can continue to offer the faith support and development that we all have come to depend upon.

In all of this, there is not only a need to address current and probable future financial shortcomings. There is also an opportunity to build the strength of our faith and our parish community. I am asking you to please prayerfully consider making a special financial Pylypiwka (Advent)gift to the parish. Know each gift makes a difference and will be met with gratitude. Please also take the time to fill in your current email and cell number. This way we can bring our parish records up to date and keep in contact with you while gathering restrictions are still in place.

These are indeed unprecedented times in which the challenges facing our world are casting shadows over our lives. Yet no amount of darkness has power over even the smallest glimmer of light. As Catholic Christians, we are called to be light for the world:

"You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden.

Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on a stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven." (Matthew 5:14-16.)

May your hearts, homes, and loved ones near and far be filled with peace, joy, and love. The Light of the world is coming!

The Prairie Centre for Ecumenism and the Regina Council of Churches

This year, due to the pandemic, we are not able to hold our regular events and so the Prairie Centre for Ecumenism and Regina Council of Churches have decided to partner and hold an 8-day virtual Bible study series based on the themes for Week of Prayer 2021 which will run Monday January 18th- Monday January 25th from 12:15-1:00pm daily over Zoom.

The theme for Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2021 is "Abide in my love and you shall bear much fruit("John 15:5-9) and materials have been prepared by the Monastic Community of Grandchamp in Switzerland. This theme is developed through a series of reflections which extend over eight days and will be the basis of the Bible study. Each day will be led by a different denominational leader.

The daily themes are as follows:

Day 1 - Monday, January 18th: Called by God: "You did not choose me but I chose you" (John 15:16a)

Day 2 - Tuesday, January 19th: Maturing Internally:

"Abide in me as I abide in you" (John 15:4)

Day 3 - Wednesday, January 20th: Forming One Body: "Love one another as I have loved you" (John 15:12b)

Day 4 - Thursday, January 21st: **Praying Together**: "I do not call you servants any longer...but I have called you friends" (John 15:15)

Day 5 - Friday, January 22nd: Letting Oneself Be Transformed by the Word: "You have already been pruned by the word..." (John 15:3)

Day 6 - Saturday, January 23rd: Welcoming Others: "Go and bear fruit, fruit that will last" (John 15:16b)

Day 7 - Sunday, January 24th: Growing in Unity: "I am the vine, you are the branches" (John 15:5a)

Day 8 - Monday, January 25th: **Reconciling with all Creation**: "So that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be complete" (John 15:11)



"SHARE THE SPIRIT" 50/50 LOTTERY DRAW (Lottery License - #LR20 - 0030)

The "Share the Spirit" 50/50 Lottery Draw concluded on December 4th, 2020 with the drawing of the winning 50/50 Lottery Ticket. The draw was supervised and conducted by Willie Birss of Baker Tilly, Chartered Professional Accountants.

The response to this Lottery was again exceptional this year, a record-breaking year (*THANK YOU*). There were 3,290 tickets sold which means that the gross ticket sales amounted to \$65,800. The winning portion of the 50/50 draw was half of the gross ticket sales, or \$32,900. The winner of this amount was Greg & Lori Hudye from Kamsack SK.

In addition to the winner's portion of the 50/50 draw, purchasers of the lottery ticket were able to designate a Parish/Mission or a designated Eparchial Organization to receive 25% of the ticket price, or \$5.00 from each ticket sold. Therefore, a Parish/Mission or the designated Eparchial Organization will receive \$5.00 for each time they were named as the designated beneficiary on the ticket purchased. The total amount that will be shared among 67 Parishes/Missions and 4 Eparchial Organizations will be \$16,450. Over the past 3 years, the Parish/Missions or designated Eparchial Organizations have received \$45,780 from the proceeds of the Lottery. Cheques to these organizations will be going out next week.

In closing, we would like to extend a huge and heartfelt *THANK YOU* to everyone who supported the 2020 "Share the Spirit" Lottery Draw and purchased these lottery tickets. Your support of this lottery is very gratefully appreciated, and we look forward to your participation and support next year.

PS: If you have not yet returned your UNSOLD ticket book, please mail them to the Foundation Office, or bring it your Parish Office. It is important to remember that under the Lottery License rules ALL tickets, SOLD OR UNSOLD must be returned to the Foundation Office.



Virtual Dying Healed Workshop: January 16, 2021 Time: 9:30 am-3:00 pm

This workshop will provide comprehensive education on palliative care/end of life issues and preliminary training for palliative and hospice care volunteers. Also suitable for those wishing to provide compassion and support to those in need, particularly at end of life.

The Dying Healed workshop covers important issues about human suffering, human dignity, and the power of human presence as well as other end-of-life issues.
