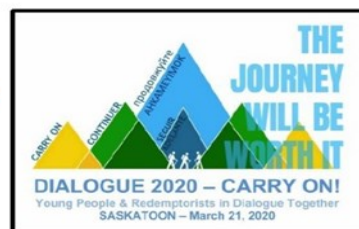

PROCEDURE FOR APRIL 4TH SOBOR

1. Discussions at the Pastoral/District level on the Sobor topics and registration of participants must be completed by March 20th, responding to the following aspects:

a. Identify the strengths and weaknesses of the Parish/ District/ Eparchy with respect to immigration, migration, settlement and unity at the deanery, district and parish levels;

1. Financial (Labour; Tax) Education
2. Health (benefits) Education
3. Faith (sacraments; catechesis; membership; pastoral care)
4. Living (housing; food; clothing; transportation; school)
5. Other

2. Pastors will come to the Sobor with two Delegates (perhaps many other observers) from each Pastoral District and the results from each of the topics outlined above District level. (Arrival at 8:30-9:00 am to register).
3. At the Sobor Pastors and Pastoral District Delegates will meet as a Deanery in breakout sessions. This session is to be chaired and facilitated by the Dean. Purpose of the session is to share results of the discussions held in the various Pastoral Districts. The groups are to agree upon only two action choices for a,b,c discussed.
4. Action items coming from breakout session groups will be collated, edited for duplication by the recorders over the lunch break and presented at the general large group session in the afternoon.
5. General session will allow for people to speak for and against each action item and then a vote will be taken to determine the Eparchial priority. Eligible voters will be asked to choose the top priority. Items receiving the most votes become the top priority. A second vote will be taken to identify the next priority when the top priority has been eliminated. This will be done for each category of the items from the decree.
6. Production of the final document will be the responsibility of the Bishop
7. In accordance with Canon Law C 238 (10∞ lay people elected by the pastoral council, if it exists, or designated in some other manner determined by the eparchial bishop so that the number of lay people does not exceed one-third of the members of the eparchial assembly) Deans will put all eligible names into a hat and from the hat select up to 3 names to vote (adhering to the formula above)?
8. Participants in the Sobor is not limited to voters and may include any parishioner from the Eparchy. Observers to the Sobor must register. Observers are not allowed vote and may contribute to the Deanery discussions in the morning. Selected delegates by Deans, will vote (with respect to the formula for number of voters).

**UKRAINIAN CATHOLIC FOUNDATION OF SASKATCHEWAN
GRANT FUND PROGRAM – DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS**

In October 20019 the Ukrainian Catholic Foundation called for applications for the Ukrainian Catholic Foundation Grant Fund Program. This Grant Fund was established when the Sheptytsky Institute building was sold, and the proceeds of sale were used to establish the Ukrainian Catholic Foundation Grant Fund Program.
