

My brother priests and all faithful in the Eparchy of Saskatoon:

The Faith Leaders' Working Group met with the government liaisons earlier on Tuesday, April 13th, and at 3:00 pm the Premier Scott Moe and Dr. Shahab announced the new measures in response to the growing numbers of COVID-19 infections across Saskatchewan.

New measures for all Saskatchewan

These restrictions apply to all places in Saskatchewan. Both of these measures are a return to the guidelines in effect earlier this year.

- Effective Friday, April 16th, all places of worship in Saskatchewan will be limited to a maximum capacity of 30 persons. All existing provisions including 2 metre distancing, hand sanitizing, masking, and contact tracing will remain in effect: (Places of worship guidelines).
 For clarity: the regulations permit concurrent meetings, but the combined capacity within the facility may not exceed 30 persons; the capacity limit applies to all persons within the place of worship except clergy/religious leadership and key staff/volunteers. Please keep this number as low as possible.
- Effective immediately, April 13th, all private indoor gatherings are prohibited immediately. Residents may not expand their household "bubble". All indoor gatherings are restricted to immediate household members only.

Reminder: outdoor public gatherings are limited to 10 people, provided physical distancing between households can be maintained.

These measures are included in the current public health order that expires on April 26th. We can expect further information on the renewal of the health order next week.



Call for Special General Meeting to the Membership of St. George's Cathedral Parish regarding Amendment to Articles and Bylaw for St. George's Ukrainian Senior Citizens Centre Corporation. **Date of Special General Meeting: Sunday, May 30, 2021 following the 9:30 am Divine Liturgy in the Cathedral Auditorium.**

MOTION TO AMEND ARTICLES

WHEREAS:

- A. The Articles of the Corporation filed October 30, 2018, provide as follows in paragraphs c and d of the Other Provisions:
 - c. The directors shall serve without remuneration and no director shall, directly or indirectly, benefit financially from his position as director provided that a director shall be entitled to indemnification for all reasonable costs, charges, and expenses incurred by him in the performance of his duties.
 - d. Officers of the Corporation shall serve without remuneration and no officer shall directly or indirectly, benefit financially from his position as an officer provided that an officer shall be entitled to indemnification for all reasonable costs, charges, and expenses incurred by him in the performance of his duties.
- B. The Directors of the Corporation believe that it would be beneficial to the Corporation for the purposes of recruiting and retaining qualified personnel that the Directors be given the discretion to fix the remuneration of the Directors and officers

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. Paragraphs c and d of the Other Provisions of the Articles be repealed and replaced with the following paragraphs:
 - c. Directors of the Corporation shall be entitled to indemnification for all reasonable costs, charges, and expenses incurred in the performance of their duties as well as to such remuneration as may be fixed by the Board of Directors.
 - d. Officers of the Corporation shall be entitled to indemnification for all reasonable costs, charges, and expenses incurred in the performance of their duties as well as to such remuneration as may be fixed by the Board of Directors.

MOTION TO AMEND BYLAW

WHEREAS:

- A. Paragraph 6.10.1 of Bylaw No. 1 of the Corporation provides as follows:
 - The directors shall serve without remuneration and no director shall directly or indirectly, benefit financially from his position as director.
- B. Paragraph 8.3.1 of Bylaw No. 1 of the Corporation provides as follows:
 - Officers of the Corporation shall serve without remuneration and no officer shall directly or indirectly, benefit financially from his position as officer of the Corporation.
- C. The Directors of the Corporation believe that it would be beneficial to the Corporation for the purposes of recruiting and retaining qualified personnel that the Directors be given the discretion to fix the remuneration of the Directors and officers.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. Paragraph 6.10.1 of Bylaw No. 1 of the Corporation be amended to read as follows:
 - Directors of the Corporation shall be entitled to receive such remuneration as may be fixed by Board of Directors.
- Paragraph 8.3.1 of Bylaw No. 1 of the Corporation be amended to read as follows:Officers of the Corpo ration shall be entitled to receive such remuneration as may be fixed by the Board of Directors.




Kindergarten Registration for Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools is
