COVID19 AND CATHOLIC CHURCH TEACHING REGARDING VACCINATION. Answers to Key Ethical Questions About Covid 19 Vaccines

"As of the date of this writing, hundreds of vaccines for Covid-19 are in development worldwide, and more than a dozen are in the final stages of testing. Some don't use abortion-derived cells lines at all, some have used such cell lines to test the vaccine's efficacy, and some are using such cell lines in the development and /or the production phases. Neither **Pfizer nor Moderna** used an abortion-derived cell line in the development or production of the vaccine. However, such a cell line was used to test the efficacy of both vaccines. Thus, while neither vaccine is completely free from any use of abortion-derived cell lines, in these two cases the use is very remote from the initial evil of the abortion. "

Bylaw Change: Bylaw 7.3.2 (c) – Change the number of elected directors from each deanery from one to two. Effective January 1, 2021, the number of Deaneries in the Eparchy changed from 4 Deaneries to 2 Deaneries. This bylaw change retains the number of elected directors at 4.

This Tuesday afternoon, March 9, 2021 the province of Saskatchewan, along with Dr. Saqib Shahab, Saskatchewan's Chief Medical Health Officer, announced a revised public health orders that will take effective on Friday, March 19th and will remain as follows for places of worship, unless otherwise amended.

The revisions affecting places of worship are as follows:

- The total number of people participating in the services cannot exceed 30 per cent of seating capacity or 150 people, whichever is less.
 - This does not include the minimal number of clergy and other leaders required to facilitate the service. However, faith communities are encouraged to keep this number at a reasonable level.
- Attendees still must stay 2 metres apart from each other and wear masks.
- Only clergy may remove their mask while officiating but must maintain 3 meters physical distance from all other attendees while mask is removed.
- These guidelines apply to all worship services, including celebrations of life, weddings and outdoor ceremonies. However, these guidelines do not apply to receptions or nonceremonial gatherings.
- (Unchanged) Services must be held in their usual location. Concurrent services in other rooms within the facility are not permitted.
- (Unchanged) Non-ceremonial meetings are permitted in groups no larger than 30 as long as physical distancing can be maintained.

We are returning to the same capacity limit as last fall, however, please note that concurrent services are not permitted. You are encouraged to review your protocols as you prepare to implement these new guidelines.

All of the current directives remain in place for this coming weekend and until March 19th. That includes the maximum of 30 people allowed.

Two meter physical distancing between family units, mandatory mask wearing, and hand and surface sanitation will continue until we are instructed otherwise through the public health orders

Some other important details to review:

- Managing how people enter and exit the building, and pews, to ensure that family units do not come within 2 meters of each other. One way traffic flow is suggested (entering through one door and leaving through another).
- For the purposes of contact tracing, places of worship are required to collect and maintain a list of people that are present within their facilities for any purposes. Contact details must include date, time, name, address, and phone number or email address.
 - When collecting contact details, avoid the sharing of pens or other common touch instruments unless disinfected between each use.
 - Contact registration lists must be maintained confidentially by the place of worship and destroyed after 30 days.
- Remind attendees to continue to do self-assessments before going to a place of worship. If they are feeling unwell, they should stay home.
- Attendees who are medically vulnerable are strongly encouraged to delay their return to services and continue to participate in services online, where possible.
- While choirs and singing by congregation members are permitted in places of worship, caution is advised as singing is a high-risk activity. Choir members who are not part of the same family must maintain at least three meters of separation from each other and from the rest of the congregation.

Optional as requested by the Premier in a meeting last week:

We are asked to encourage anyone who is scheduled to have a vaccine within a few days of a religious service, not to go to worship that day and to wait until after they have received the vaccine, especially those who are over 60.
