ON THE OCCASION OF THE WORLD DAY OF PRAYER
FOR THE CHURCH IN CHINA (24 MAY 2008)

Virgin Most Holy, Mother of the Incarnate Word and our Mother, venerated in the Shrine of Sheshan under the title "Help of Christians", the entire Church in China looks to you with devout affection.

We come before you today to implore your protection. Look upon the People of God and, with a mother's care, guide them along the paths of truth and love, so that they may always be a leaven of harmonious coexistence among all citizens.

When you obediently said "yes" in the house of Nazareth, you allowed God's eternal Son to take flesh in your virginal womb and thus to begin in history the work of our redemption.

You willingly and generously cooperated in that work, allowing the sword of pain to pierce your soul, until the supreme hour of the Cross, when you kept watch on Calvary, standing beside your Son, who died that we might live.

From that moment, you became, in a new way, the Mother of all those who receive your Son Jesus in faith and choose to follow in his footsteps by taking up his Cross. Mother of hope, in the darkness of Holy Saturday you journeyed with unfailing trust towards the dawn of Easter.

Grant that your children may discern at all times, even those that are darkest, the signs of God's loving presence.

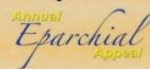

Call for Special General Meeting to the Membership of St. George's Cathedral Parish regarding Amendment to Articles and Bylaw for St. George's Ukrainian Senior Citizens Centre Corporation. **Date of Special General Meeting: Sunday, May 30, 2021 following the 9:30 am Divine Liturgy in the Cathedral Auditorium.**

MOTION TO AMEND ARTICLES

WHEREAS:

- A. The Articles of the Corporation filed October 30, 2018, provide as follows in paragraphs c and d of the Other Provisions:
 - c. The directors shall serve without remuneration and no director shall, directly or indirectly, benefit financially from his position as director provided that a director shall be entitled to indemnification for all reasonable costs, charges, and expenses incurred by him in the performance of his duties.
 - d. Officers of the Corporation shall serve without remuneration and no officer shall directly or indirectly, benefit financially from his position as an officer provided that an officer shall be entitled to indemnification for all reasonable costs, charges, and expenses incurred by him in the performance of his duties.
- B. The Directors of the Corporation believe that it would be beneficial to the Corporation for the purposes of recruiting and retaining qualified personnel that the Directors be given the discretion to fix the remuneration of the Directors and officers.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. Paragraphs c and d of the Other Provisions of the Articles be repealed and replaced with the following paragraphs:
 - c. Directors of the Corporation shall be entitled to indemnification for all reasonable costs, charges, and expenses incurred in the performance of their duties as well as to such remuneration as may be fixed by the Board of Directors.
 - d. Officers of the Corporation shall be entitled to indemnification for all reasonable costs, charges, and expenses incurred in the performance of their duties as well as to such remuneration as may be fixed by the Board of Directors.

MOTION TO AMEND BYLAW

WHEREAS:

- A. Paragraph 6.10.1 of Bylaw No. 1 of the Corporation provides as follows:
The directors shall serve without remuneration and no director shall directly or indirectly, benefit financially from his position as director.
- B. Paragraph 8.3.1 of Bylaw No. 1 of the Corporation provides as follows:
Officers of the Corporation shall serve without remuneration and no officer shall directly or indirectly, benefit financially from his position as officer of the Corporation.
- C. The Directors of the Corporation believe that it would be beneficial to the Corporation for the purposes of recruiting and retaining qualified personnel that the Directors be given the discretion to fix the remuneration of the Directors and officers.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. Paragraph 6.10.1 of Bylaw No. 1 of the Corporation be amended to read as follows:
Directors of the Corporation shall be entitled to receive such remuneration as may be fixed by Board of Directors.
- 2. Paragraph 8.3.1 of Bylaw No. 1 of the Corporation be amended to read as follows: Officers of the Corporation shall be entitled to receive such remuneration as may be fixed by the Board of Directors.

Dear Bishop Bryan, brothers' priest and faithful of Saskatoon Eparchy!

The Faith Leaders' Working Group met with our government liaisons again today. As you know, the Saskatchewan Re-opening Roadmap will begin Step 1 on Sunday May 30. We have sought clarification on a number of details raised by you or another faith leader. Here is a summary of the upcoming changes:

In Step 1, beginning Sunday, May 30:

- **maximum capacity of a place of worship will be increased to 30% of seating capacity, with a maximum of 150 people in the entire facility.**
 - 2 metre distancing, masking, sanitizing, and contact tracing will continue to be required.
 - sharing food or drink is prohibited in Step 1.
 - other non-worship gatherings will be allowed to a maximum of **30 people**.
 - non-worship gatherings held concurrently with a worship service are allowed but the total number of people in the worship service and additional gathering may not exceed 150 people.
- non-essential travel is not recommended outside Saskatchewan

In Step 2, beginning June 20, there will be few changes affecting places of worship:

- maximum capacity will remain 30% of seating capacity, with a maximum of 150 people in the entire facility
 - 2 metre distancing, masking, sanitizing, and contact tracing will continue to be required.
 - sharing food or drink is prohibited in Step 2.
 - other non-worship gatherings will be allowed to a maximum of **150 people**.
 - non-worship gatherings held concurrently with a worship service are allowed but the total number of people in the worship service and additional gathering may not exceed 150 people.
- non-essential travel is not recommended outside Saskatchewan.

Step 3 is anticipated in mid-July. In Step 3 most restrictions will be lifted. There will be no limits on capacity, food and drink will be permitted, physical distancing and contact tracing will not be required. It is expected that masks and sanitizing will be advised for some time, but the public health emergency will end, and the public health orders will be lifted soon after Step 3 begins.

Due to the continuing high infection rates in both Alberta and Manitoba, travel will not be recommended even in Step 3. The entire SK Roadmap is contingent on the continuing decline in infection rates. Please continue to cooperate with public health authorities and encourage vaccination.

Health officials are still considering when large gatherings such as conferences and sporting events will be able to resume. Further advice will be provided in the coming weeks.
