Dear Parishioners,

It is with excitement, that the Cathedral Maintenance Committee, announces the beginning of the Cathedral Stair Campaign!

The maintenance committee has been working hard determining the extent of the damage to the stairs and what the appropriate course should be to remedy the situation. After consulting with various people who have experience and knowledge in construction and specifically in concrete construction, the Committee has recommended to Parish Council that a full replacement of the entrance stairs is the best course of action.

The next steps will be to get a design complete based on the maintenance committee recommendations and getting quotes from several contractors to do the work.

While this may take some time, Parish Council would like to start raising funds for this task as soon as possible. The maintenance committee suggests due to the scale of the project, the current projected budget is approximately \$40,000. This is just an estimated budget for now and will be refined as the design is finalized and quotes for the work can be obtained. The goal will be to complete this project late summer 2022

The Maintenance Committee would like to thank you for your patience with the condition of the front stairs and encourages everyone to give as much as they can to help restore the beauty of our Cathedral entrance as soon as possible.

Very shortly each Parish Family in the Eparchy will receive a package containing information concerning this lottery draw and tickets for purchase. Please check your mailbox for your package.


