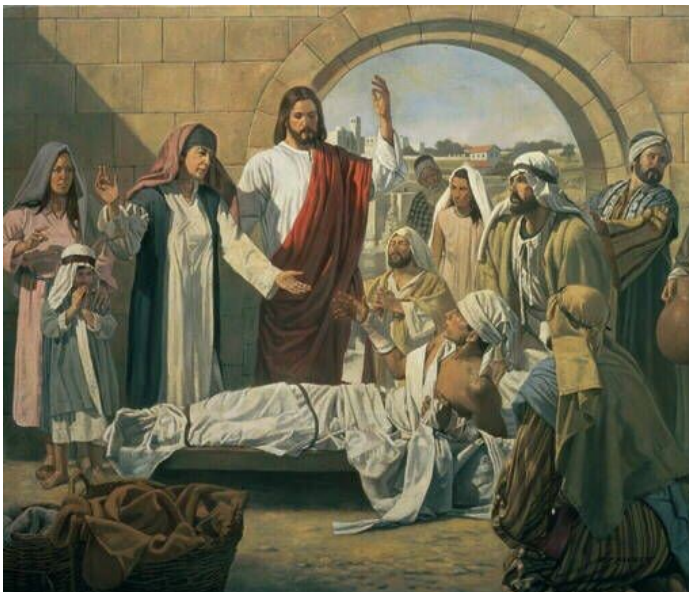

Have you heard the Good News?

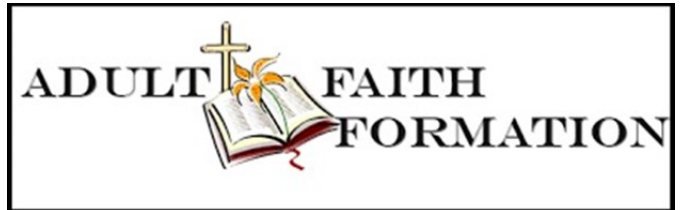

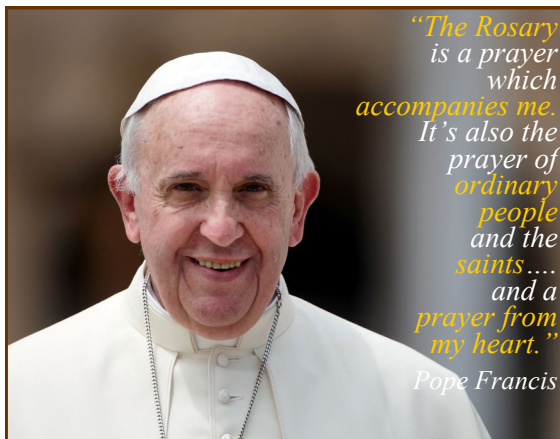
