

GLORY BE TO JESUS CHRIST! СЛАВА ИСУС ХРИСТУ!

Dear brothers' priest and faithful of Saskatoon Eparchy!

I hope that you have had a restful summer and that you remain healthy and safe. As the COVID infection rate rises in Saskatchewan, today the Government has announced new public health orders. The details affecting places of worship are as follows:

Mandatory mask order:

Effective on Friday, September 17, **masks must be worn in every indoor public space**. This means that places of worship will need to ensure that all attending services are wearing masks. It also means that anyone in your buildings must be masked at all times.

Is there a worship leader exemption? We are expecting that specific guidelines will be prepared to implement this mandatory mask order. There will probably be an exemption for the principal worship leader and for the employees in the privacy of their offices. However, these guidelines have not been released yet, so the precise details are unknown. Until further notice, please wear masks indoors at all times.

Proof of vaccination:

Effective October 1, there will be a proof of vaccination policy affecting public access to numerous businesses and other public buildings. **Places of worship are exempt** from the proof of vaccination policy.

The Government is requiring vaccination for all government employees and is asking private employers to implement a similar policy. Places of worship are free to implement this policy if you choose, but it will not be mandated by government.

It is hoped that once the proof of vaccination policy is implemented that masking will not be required. It is not clear whether masking will still be required in those places exempt from the proof of vaccination policy.

The government is committed to providing a simple mechanism for displaying a proof of vaccination or proof of negative test. This will be available by October 1.

Mandatory self-isolation:

Already announced last week, the government is requiring that all people who test positive for COVID self-isolate for 10 days. Unvaccinated people with a close contact must isolate for 14 days. Fully vaccinated people who have a close contact must self-monitor.

The mandatory self-isolation order does not directly affect places of worship. However, anyone who suspects that they might be infected with a communicable disease is required to seek testing and avoid close interactions with others.

We expect to have further details on the implementation of these policies in the next days.

Continuation of: New public health orders affecting places of worship

In summary:

Please continue to be cautious and prudent. Encourage regular hand sanitizing. Physical distancing is not required but is encouraged. Physical touching (shaking hands, hugging, etc...) is discouraged. There are no indications yet whether there will be limits on serving food or beverages in places of worship.

Section 4. (c)(vi) clarifies that the worship leader may be unmasked when distanced by 3 metres from others. Note that "leading a service" is defined by the act of speaking and proximity to the podium. This would not apply to a choir or band leading a worship service.

4. (c)(vii) refers to musical performers playing wood or brass instruments only. These musicians are permitted to be unmasked when properly distanced. We have asked for clarity about soloists and other singers.

4. (d)(ii) answers a question received about distribution of Communion. It is permissible to lower the mask briefly to consume the elements, however this should be done carefully.

4. (d)(vi) is similar to the previous masking order. This permits people in the privacy of their offices to remove their masks. When another staff person or visitor enters the office, everyone should wear a mask.

Dear Friends in Christ:

Re: Stewardship Conference 2021

I am convoking an Eparchial Stewardship Conference for October 23, 2021 after discussing several topics with the College of Consultors, Presbyteral Council, including: update of Stewardship Parish, District and Deanery plans.

When: Saturday October 23, 2021
Time: Registration 8:00AM Conference 9:00AM till 4:00PM
Where: St. George's Senior Centre (1235 20th Street West, corner of Ave M & 20th) as well as online for representatives.
Who & What: Stewardship Conference for Clergy, and Parish Delegates (One rep per parish and of these reps, try to have one per District under 35 years of age [young adult]).

Step #1. Each priest is expected to give a 10 minute presentation on their district with a rep from their district. I would ask that the clergy meet with their districts to renew the information found in the D Forms that were completed in 2018 so that the information can be updated. Feel free to contact Nestor Halaitso for what the Chancery Office currently has on your district if you are not sure. It is possible that some priests who were moved recently or assigned additional districts since 2018 will see the D forms for the first time. A summary of the presentation are to be made available to Nestor.

Step #2. A Financial Report (Covid Impact, Demographic Impact) regarding our 15-year Financial Forecast will be presented by Adrian Olenick.

Step #3. Small Group discussion to address current and future challenges. Reflection on these questions:

- Consider these factors: # of services per year; # and age of parishioners; condition of building; location in district; demands on clergy to minister to larger areas... How is your district and parish responding to this?
- How is your parish sustained by the Eparchy and how is the Eparchy sustained by your parish since one depends on the other to carry out the Mission of Jesus Christ? How are roles changing?
- How are cemeteries cared for now and moving forward by Good Stewards when a parish might close and a cemetery becomes the concern of others that never used to care for it? Who will care for your grave and the cemetery you are buried in if/when your local parish closes?
- What are the advantages for the parishes of a pastoral district to work together in areas of priests' salaries, rectory expenses, service schedules, etc? What are the drawbacks?
