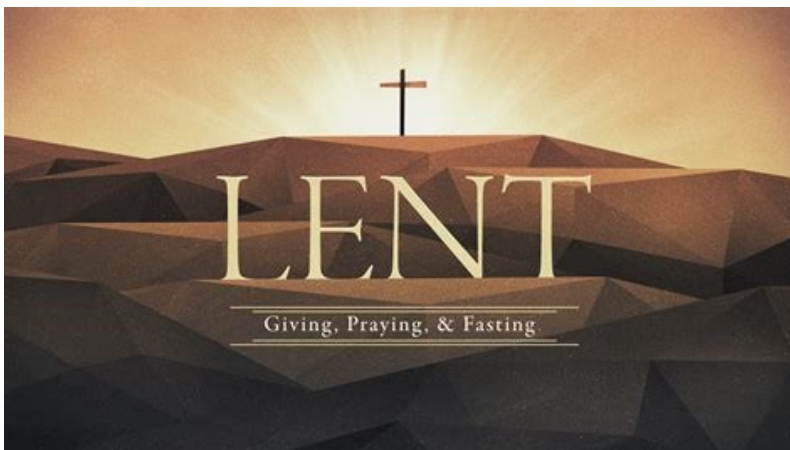

Introduction

In May, 2023, Bishop Roborecki Branch UCBC will be celebrating its 90th anniversary – 90 years since it came into being on May 14, 1933. This historic event will take place in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan in fifteen months.

This is the first of a series of fifteen informational articles that will appear monthly in preparation for Bishop Roborecki Branch's 90th anniversary. Each article will focus on a different theme. An effort will be made to provide both a historical perspective and a contemporary account of the branch's activities.

The information that will be used will draw on *The History of the Ukrainian Catholic Brotherhood of Canada – Eparchy of Saskatoon (2,000)*, archival material housed in Musée Ukraina Museum, *Ukrainian Catholic Brotherhood of Canada Constitution and By-Laws (1986)*, and conversations with the elders in the branch. RESCUING PETER: Jesus and the Unpredictable Disciple - a three-part Zoom series for Lent with Sr. Teresita Kambeitz OSU. **Thursdays, March 17, 24 & 31, 2:00 - 4:00 p.m., repeated 7:00 - 9:00 p.m.** In this Lenten series, we will reflect on the graced ways in which Jesus saves impulsive Peter from himself. Peter is us! Join Sr. Teresita and learners from around the world on Zoom as we explore this compelling topic. We will enter into interactions between Peter and Jesus, noting how their relationship develops over time. Jesus rescues Peter from himself! Drawing from the teachings of Thomas Merton, Jesus appears to be in the process of awakening Simon Peter to awareness of his "false self" - his facade of defenses and pretenses - and calling forth his "truth" - the inner rock upon which he stands in all honesty before God and others.

Presentation #1: Jesus invites Peter into a ministry-relationship and affirms his strengths.

Presentation #2: Jesus challenges Peter's assumptions and expands his horizons of faith.

Presentation #3: Jesus draws Peter into a relationship of trust, integrity and commitment.

DOORS OF OUR HEART: A Journey through Palm Sunday to Easter and Beyond - a Zoom based retreat series with Marg Janick-Grayston. Each segment of this retreat series will begin with a time of exploring the theme for the week by walking through the biblical story together and deepening our experience through pondering reflective writings, music, videos and/or poetry, as well as a time of sharing insights gleaned. IMPORTANT NOTE - In our Byzantine Eastern Rite, Monday, February 28th, is the first day of The Great Fast (Lent). On this day, we are all obligated to keep a strict fast all day long from all meat and dairy products - and what we do eat should be in modest, smaller portions, reflecting our willing and cheerful spirit of self-denial and sacrifice during the Lenten season.

STRICT ABSTINENCE is to be observed on the first day of the Great Fast, February 28th, and on Good Friday, April 15. The law of strict abstinence forbids the use of meat, eggs, and dairy products. Put simply, no meat or dairy all day long.

SIMPLE ABSTINENCE is to be observed every Friday during Lent. The law of simple abstinence forbids the use of meat. Put simply, no meat all day long. Simple abstinence (no meat) is strongly encouraged on the Wednesdays of the Great Fast.

The following are exempt from abstinence: the poor who live on alms; the sick and frail; those convalescing; women who are pregnant and mothers who are nursing; those who perform hard labor; children under the age of 14; and those who are 59 or older, (only with the permission of their pastor or confessor). If you are not in the above exceptions, you are bound to Lenten fasting.
