MY WEEK IN REVIEW

Glory be to Jesus Christ! I'm starting to see a pattern here with three categories of MY WEEK IN REVIEW: Cathedral/NB/Hafford, Eparchy and Personal. Cathedral/NB/Hafford: First Confession and First Solemn Communion was the highlight tied with Baptism and Uhrynow Praznyk, the feast of Ascension and now we have 10 days of waiting for the Holy Spirit at the feast of Pentecost, May devotion (Funny story that on Wednesday is that I told some people Molebyn at 6:30 and others at 7:00 so I celebrated twice), St George's Residence meeting, Parish council meeting, marriage prep, and I am seeking to understand youth ministry. There are many very talented people who have very beautiful intentions, but we are not coordinating our efforts. In June I will be trying to gather these people for pray and discussion so that we may begin to have a common vision. This discussion is even more urgent in light of the fact that the Eparchial Youth Ministry office will cease to exist after WYD in September. Eparchy: Three very big things happening. First the "searching for a priest". The bishops of Canada are helping and we hosted a priest last weekend who will share with us his decision by the end of May. Covenant of Care requires some strengthening in our policy and practice. The Grant Fund had a meeting to decide who will receive and how much they will get. This money will not be dispersed until the end of June but decisions are being made now. Then more boring jobs, but essential, like changing signing authority. Personal: The big news is that this week Debbie and I celebrated our 38th wedding anniversary. I did some biking, fixing Debbie's raised garden, attended the Vyshyvanka party at our Museum, gave a friend a ride for his chemo treatment and attended a house party for my Godchild's 1st birthday.

Слава Ісусу Христу! Я бачу тут шаблон із трьома категоріями ОГЛЯДУ МОГО ТИЖНЯ: Катедра/НБ/Гаффорд, Єпархія та особисте. Катедра/НБ/Гаффорд: Перша Сповідь і Перше Урочисте Причастя були найвизначнішими моментами, які пов'язані також з Хрещенням і Празником в Угринові, святом Вознесіння, а тепер у нас є 10 днів очікування на Святого Духа у свято П'ятидесятниці, травневе богослужіння (кумедна історія, я сказав деяким людям, що молебень о 6:30, а іншим о 7:00, тож я святкував двічі), збори резиденції Святого Юрія, збори парафіяльної ради, підготовка до шлюбу, і я прагну зрозуміти молодіжне служіння. Багато є дуже талановитих людей, які мають дуже гарні наміри, але ми не координуємо наші зусилля. У червні я намагатимуся зібрати цих людей для молитви та обговорення, щоб ми могли мати спільне бачення. Це обговорення є ще більш актуальним у світлі того факту, що після СДМ у вересні Єпархіальний відділ молодіжного служіння припинить своє існування. Єпархія: відбулися три дуже важливі речі. Спочатку «пошук священника». Єпископи Канади допомагають, і минулих вихідних ми прийняли священника, який скаже нам своє рішення до кінця травня. Угода про турботу потребує певного посилення нашої процедури та практики. Відбулися збори грантового фонду, щоб вирішити, хто і скільки отримає. Ці гроші не будуть розподілені до кінця червня, але рішення приймається зараз. Далі ще більш нудні роботи, але необхідні, як-от зміна повноважень підпису. Особисте: велика новина полягає в тому, що цього тижня ми з Деббі відсвяткували 38-му річницю весілля. Я трохи покатався на велосипеді, полагодив город Деббі, відвідав вечірку «Вишиванка» в нашому музеї, підвіз друга на хіміотерапію та відвідав домашню вечірку з нагоди першого дня народження мого хрещеника.
