Eparchy: WE HAVE A NEW BISHOP! What else needs to be said? PATRIARCH SVIATOSLAV WAS HERE FOR 6 DAYS. We are so blessed. I could write pages about: the liturgical events, the visiting clergy and religious, the great job done by the choirs, the food, the ticket organization, etc. It was all wonderful. The churches were full to capacity, the livestream was available for everyone else. Some of my favorite words from His Beatitude: “Axios (He is worthy)” and to the newly arrived Ukrainians: “Integrate, and you will be a strength for Ukraine, assimilate, and she will become weak.” And also “Insert yourselves into the structures that exist here.”

Cathedral: I can’t believe that all this was in one week. I also attended 2 meetings for the Millenium Cross Foundation, Water Blessing at St. John Bosco School, Parish Council meeting and 2 Catechist meetings.

Personal: I was tired after the Patriarch left. On Wednesday, I did gentle jobs around the house. I also had military commitments with my regular Wednesday night training, a Teams meeting with 38 Brigade Chaplains, made a visit to a family whose son died and attended the funeral prayers.

Getting Married?

Congratulations!

We wish you every blessing. Here is how to begin your sacramental preparation...

All couples who are planning marriage over the next year should speak to their Parish Priest
as soon as possible.

Couples are also encouraged to register for an approved Marriage Preparation Course such as the **Crown the With Honor and Glory Course** developed in the Eparchy of Saskatoon to prepare specifically for marriage in the Ukrainian Catholic Church.

This program includes both self-study of the **Crown Them with Honor and Glory** Booklet, online Inventory with guided reflections (FOCCUS), and in-person or zoom class/retreat sessions. While the self-study and Inventory are independent couple work, the sessions require real time attendance online or in person at St. George's Cathedral if possible (special circumstances may be accommodated).

Our Dear Displaced Ukrainians,

I would like to bring to your attention a project that the students of our Ukrainian program at Bethlehem Catholic High School are launching – a book of Ukrainian immigration stories through the eyes of displaced young people (the sixth wave of immigration). Our goal is to publish a bilingual book with the stories of high school Ukrainians of our Catholic school division (GSCS) who arrived from different parts of Ukraine due to the scaled invasion of russia, their sharing of how the war impacted them personally as well as their families, and their adaptation to Canadian society. Their stories can be submitted in Ukrainian, and we will then translate them into English. It will be a bilingual book with both Ukrainian and English versions of each story. This book will be a valuable treasure and legacy for our future generations shared by young Ukrainians, witnesses of this horrible war time.

We would like to ask you for your assistance in spreading this information and encouraging your Ukrainian displaced young friends to write their stories. Those who are interested to share their stories are asked to contact me to register (VMarko@gscs.ca).

Students who choose to submit their story do not have to provide the real names of themselves, of their family members, officials or people in authority, of individuals who assisted them, or of towns/villages/cities, or regions. They may use pseudonyms if they wish to remain anonymous. This is acceptable. If there are any questions, you can always send me an email. Thank you!

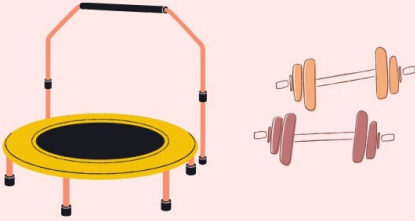
