

Preparing for Remembrance Day is a big deal for a chaplain of the military, especially because we include many multi-faith leaders. I was blessed to receive and give away a big beautiful dining room table. I love having the trust of so many friends. Speaking of trust it is a great honor to be trusted by people to be involved in funeral planning. These most delicate and emotional moments are when I am invited and consulted and it is a privilege every time. Thank you for your trust. **New idea:** Is Canada the foreign country where we now live or is it our new land? There is a moment when these realities meet. It is sometimes subtle, but it is sometimes a very conscious decision. To accept Canada as your new country does not mean that you abandon the country of your birth. There are some events that bring this question into focus. Where should I baptize my child, where should I burry my loved one, who should I marry and where should my wedding be held? RECTORY AND CATHEDRAL OFFICE ROOF PROJECT


The rectory and cathedral office buildings consists of multiple roofs in order to cover a large footprint. The roof area that is directly above the west entrance to the cathedral office is much lower than the roofs to the north and south of the cathedral entrance roof. This lower roof area is subject to significant snow drift buildup which contributes to consequential damages to the building. This accumulation of snow above the lower roof area is subject to numerous cycles of freeze and thaw that creates ice dams at the



lower west edge of the lower roof. This ice damming has progressively caused damage to the building cladding and perhaps even some amount of damage to parts of the underlying roof.

In an effort to reduce the extent of damage to the building over the lower roof area, workers are required following heavy snow falls to access this roof area and hand shovel the snow off of the roof. This is both dangerous and timely work.

Total estimated cost of the above remedial work, including all applicable taxes is \$21,600. Please consider providing a donation specific to the cost of the Rectory-Cathedral Office Roof Project. Project envelopes coming soon.
