If and when it is your turn to organize a funeral know that our prayers and support are with you. Maybe there is something we can do in advance to introduce you to the process before you have to make arrangements while grieving the loss of a loved one? Borschiw parish is preparing to decommission their church. The Rural Municipality (RM) have legislation that allows them to burn derelict buildings and so we cleaned all sacred and secular items out of the church. This is an administrative process, but it is completely pastoral too. The people have to grieve the loss of their church building. Shut-ins and visits x4. Catechism #2 went well. A few new registrations came in and the more the merrier. Also, Catechism communication app called Band is being set up. Also, Catechists Unite is a National network of Catechists had its first ever meeting. I missed the rosary last Friday, so I apologize to anyone who came to find a locked church.

Administration: meetings with: zoom call, Senior’s Residence AGM and Senior’s Residence regular meeting. Office work and time in both the cathedral and chancery offices.

Personal: I don’t follow baseball, but it is impossible not to feel the Canadian fever of excitement for the Blue Jays. Debbie and I enjoyed the MUM fundraiser, beautiful food, atmosphere and people. I had three half-days with the military this week including I learned about the Muslim communities of Saskatoon. The Dawah Center and Islamic Academy are our next-door-neighbors. In your service, Fr. 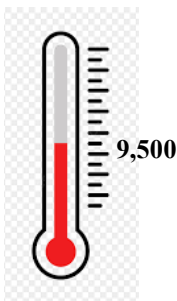
ОГЛЯД МОГО ТИЖНЯ

RECTORY AND CATHEDRAL OFFICE ROOF PROJECT



The rectory and cathedral office buildings consists of multiple roofs in order to cover a large footprint. The roof area that is directly above the west entrance to the cathedral office is much lower than the roofs to the north and south of the cathedral entrance roof. This lower roof area is subject to significant snow drift buildup which contributes to consequential damages to the building. This accumulation of snow above the lower roof area is subject to numerous cycles of freeze and thaw that creates ice dams at the lower west edge of the lower roof. This ice damming has progressively caused damage to the building cladding and perhaps even some amount of damage to parts of the underlying roof. In an effort to reduce the extent of damage to the building over the lower roof area, workers are required following heavy snow falls to access this roof area and hand shovel the snow off of the roof. This is both dangerous and timely work. Total estimated cost of the above remedial work, including all applicable taxes is \$21,600. Please consider providing a donation specific to the cost of the Rectory-Cathedral Office Roof Project. Project envelopes coming soon.
